

Purchasing Wood Sculptures

Is the purchase of a unique wood sculpture worth the investment?

The short answer to the question is yes. As with any other kind of sculpture, wood sculptures add to the enjoyment of life if you like the shape of the piece. Unlike metal, ceramic, or glass pieces, wood adds warmth to your home or office like nothing else can. Wood can complement nearly any decor.

As with any other piece of art, you are purchasing a piece of the artist. All fine art takes time, and this is especially true of original pieces that are not mass-produced. An artist is constantly balancing the aesthetic quality of the work with the time it takes (and affordability).

Unlike bronze castings which may be reproduced in quantity from an original sculpture, each wood sculpture is hand-made and one-of-a-kind. Consider them a "limited edition of one".

The option of buying a custom-made piece allows you to choose a wood that particularly appeals to you. Custom sculptures can also be made to fit your size constraints within certain limitations. Most importantly, you'll own a sculpture that is an expression of you.

Quality hardwoods can last for generations if properly cared for. As with any fine art, avoid placing the piece in direct sunlight. Exposure to ultraviolet may change the appearance of certain woods. A light dusting with a soft cloth is the only maintenance required.
